Application Documents	 Certificates, transcripts and university degree certificates in other languages have to be officially translated into English Please add German language certificates, if you did take German classes before If you want to apply for a DAAD-scholarship, you <u>must</u> fill in the DAAD-application form (download from <u>www.daad.de</u>) and upload it together with the documents requested by the DAAD therein with your online application
Application Procedure	 The application has to be filed online in the application system "C@MPUS" of the University of Stuttgart. Only complete applications with correctly uploaded documents will be evaluated.
Application Deadlines	 The application period for MIP starts in "C@MPUS" from August 1st, 2020 and ends on February 15th, 2021. Students, who want to apply for admission and for a DAAD-scholarship, have to upload the complete application documents in "C@MPUS" until September 30th, 2020. All other students have to upload the complete application documents until February 15th, 2019.
Cost	 Minimum budget for four semesters: approx. 28,000 EUR, including cost of living (incl. room, health insurance, etc.), study fees and educational expenditures. You can find a cost calculation in the download section. This is the minimum budget for a SINGLE person and does not include travel costs from and to the home country. IMPORTANT: The State of Baden-Wuerttemberg introduced a tuition fee of 1500 EUR per semester for inter- national students. This fee is included in the cost calculation.
Scholarships	 Only a very limited number of DAAD-scholarships is available, for application you MUST upload the DAAD-application form (see section "Application Deadlines" above) and the documents requested therein together with your application in "C@MPUS". For a list of possibilities to search for financial assistance see the download section. Please make use of programs in your home country and try international organizations like the World Bank or the Asian Development Bank.

Admission Procedure Student Visa	 Only complete applications will be evaluated. The admission committee meets in November for the DAAD scholarship applications. You will be informed if you are short-listed for a scholarship by E-mail in December 2020. The admission committee will decide on the self-financing applications in March/April 2021. You will see the result in your C@MPUS-account by the end of April 2021. Start immediately with the visa application for a student visa
<u>otudent</u> Visa	 Start infinediately with the visa application for a student visa upon receipt of the result. You must calculate at least 12 weeks to receive the student visa. You MUST NOT enter Germany with a Tourist Visa! This would mean to return to your home country to apply for a student visa.
Accomodation	 A limited quota of rooms for <u>single</u> students are available in student dormitories on campus, a separate application (DOI) form will be mailed in May 2021 and you will have to register in an online-system of the Studierendenwerk Stuttgart. You will receive detailed information with your admission confirmation from the MIP office by E-mail. The rooms in the MIP quota will be assigned based on the "first come first serve" principle according to the date and time the MIP office receives the filled in DOI from the candidates together with their individual code from the registration in the online system of the Studierendenwerk. NO family apartments are available in the student dormitories. Family apartments are only available on the private market, rents are high in Stuttgart. Students with family should plan to come on their own to Stuttgart at least for the duration of the first semester, as dependent visa are difficult to acquire and take several months of processing-time in Germany.
